SECTION 2. Section 478.0053, Government Code, as effective
April 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 478.0053. EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN LARGE VENUES. Section 478.0051(b)(1) does 5 6 not apply to an event described by Section <u>478.0001(3)(H)</u> [478.0001(3)(C)]. If an endorsing municipality or endorsing county 7 requests the office to make a determination under Section 478.0102 8 for an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(H) [478.0001(3)(G)], 9 the remaining provisions of this chapter apply to that event as if 10 the event satisfied the eligibility requirements under Section 11 478.0051(b)(1). 12
