- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 551.1283, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 551.1283. GOVERNING BODY OF CERTAIN WATER DISTRICTS:
- 8 INTERNET WEBSITES [POSTING OF MEETING MATERIALS]; RECORDING OF
- 9 MEETINGS [CERTAIN HEARINGS]. (a) In this section, "board" means the
- 10 governing body of a special purpose district to which this section
- 11 applies.
- 12 <u>(a-1)</u> This section only applies to a special purpose
- 13 district subject to Chapter 51, 53, 54, or 55, Water Code, that has
- 14 a population of 500 or more.
- 15 (b) A [On written request of a district resident made to the
- 16 district not later than the third day before a public hearing to
- 17 consider the adoption of an ad valorem tax rate, the] district shall
- 18 <u>develop and maintain an Internet website</u> [make an audio recording
- 19 of reasonable quality of the hearing and provide the recording to
- 20 the resident in an electronic format not later than the fifth
- 21 business day after the date of the hearing. The district shall
- 22 maintain a copy of the recording for at least one year after the
- 23 date of the hearing].
- 24 (c) A district shall make available on the district's

1 Internet website: 2 (1) contact information for each member of the board; 3 (2) the time and place of the next meeting of the 4 board; 5 (3) a live video stream of each meeting of the board; (4) a video recording of each meeting of the board 6 7 posted not later than the fifth business day after the date of the 8 meeting and maintained for not less than one year; 9 (5) the minutes of each meeting of the board; and 10 (6) information about: (A) the budget set by the district; and 11 12 (B) any tax rate set by the district [post the minutes of the meeting of the governing body to the district's 13 14 Internet website if the district maintains an Internet website]. 15 SECTION 2. Section 49.062(b), Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 16 17 (b) The board shall designate one or more places inside [or outside] the district for conducting the meetings of the board. The 18 19 meeting place may be a private residence or office, provided that the board, in its order establishing the meeting place, declares 20 the same to be a public place and invites the public to attend any 21 meeting of the board. If the board establishes that no suitable 22 place exists for meeting inside the district, a meeting place or 23

places outside the district may be designated. The board $[\frac{1}{1}]$

shall give notice of the location or locations of a meeting place or

places outside the district by filing a true copy of the resolution

establishing the location or locations of the meeting place or

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- 1 places and a justification of why the meeting will not be held in
- 2 the district or within 10 miles of the boundary of the district, if
- 3 applicable, with the commission and also by publishing notice of
- 4 the location or locations in a newspaper of general circulation in
- 5 the district. If the location of any of the meeting places outside
- 6 the district is changed, notice of the change shall be given in the
- 7 same manner.
- 8 SECTION 3. Sections 49.062(c), (c-1), (e), (f), and (g),
- 9 Water Code, are repealed.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
