## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a vendor's remedies for nonpayment of a contract with
- 3 this state or a political subdivision of this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2251.042, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) A governmental entity shall notify a vendor of an error
- 9 or disputed amount in an invoice submitted for payment by the vendor
- 10 not later than the 21st day after the date the entity receives the
- 11 invoice, and shall include in such notice a detailed statement of
- 12 the amount of the invoice which is disputed.
- 13 (d) The governmental entity may withhold from payments
- 14 required no more than 110 percent of the disputed amount.
- SECTION 2. Section 2251.042, Government Code, as amended by
- 16 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before that date
- 18 is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was
- 19 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
