A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to charging exorbitant or excessive prices for certain agricultural goods during a declared disaster. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 17.4625, Business & Commerce Code, is 5 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 6 (c) For purposes of Section 17.46(b)(27), the price of a 7 meat food product or a poultry product, as those terms are defined 8 by Section 433.003, Health and Safety Code, or an egg, as defined by 9 Section 132.001, Agriculture Code, that is sold or offered for sale 10 by a grower, producer, or processor of the product or egg is not 11 considered exorbitant or excessive if the price for the product or 12 13 egg is: 14 (1) a contract price; (2) the result of a price formula; or 15 16 (3) based on a pricing index. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an act or practice that occurs on or after the effective date of 18 this Act. An act or practice that occurs before the effective date 19 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the act or 20 practice occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for 21

22 that purpose.
