5	SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 11.009 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.009. REDACTION OF UNCONSTITUTIONAL RESTRICTIONS.
8	(a) If a grantee of an instrument conveying an interest in real
9	property believes that a restriction in the instrument violates the
10	constitution of this state or of the United States, the grantee may
11	bring an action against the county in which the instrument is
12	recorded to request the redaction of the restriction from the
13	instrument.
14	(b) An action under Subsection (a) may be brought in the
15	county in which the instrument is recorded.
16	(c) If a court finds that a restriction provided for by an
17	instrument conveying an interest in real property violates the
18	constitution of this state or of the United States, the court shall
19	enter a written order that:
20	(1) identifies the instrument and the specific
21	language that the court finds violates the constitution of this
22	state or of the United States; and
23	(2) requires the county clerk to redact the
24	restriction from the instrument.

<u>(d) On receipt of a written order from a judge issued under</u>
<u>Subsection (c), the county clerk shall redact from the instrument</u>
<u>identified by the order the specific language identified by the</u>
<u>order.</u>
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house as

6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
