10	Sec. 38A.0001. APPLICABILITY. This chapter does not apply
11	to a municipality or county with a population of less than 45,000.
12	Sec. 38A.0002. PREEMPTION CHALLENGE AGAINST POLITICAL
13	SUBDIVISION. If a court determines that an order, ordinance, or
14	similar measure of a political subdivision is unenforceable because
15	it is preempted by the state constitution or a state statute, the
16	court shall award the person prevailing in the action challenging
17	the order, ordinance, or measure on that basis court costs and
18	reasonable and necessary attorney's fees to be paid by the
19	political subdivision.
20	Sec. 38A.0003. FAILURE OF OFFICER OF POLITICAL SUBDIVISION
21	TO PERFORM CERTAIN ACTS. If a court determines that an officer of a
22	political subdivision has failed to perform an act of the office
23	required by the state constitution or a state statute, the court
24	shall award the person prevailing in the action challenging the

- 1 officer for failure to perform that act court costs and reasonable
- 2 and necessary attorney's fees to be paid by the political
- 3 subdivision for which the officer served at the time of the failure
- 4 to perform the act.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an action commenced on
- 6 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
