- 2 relating to the possession of condemned property by the condemnor
- 3 pending the results of further litigation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.021, Property Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
- 7 (e) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) After the special commissioners have made an award in a
- 9 condemnation proceeding, except as provided by Subsection (c) and
- 10 subject to Subsection (b-1) [of this section], the condemnor may
- 11 take possession of the condemned property pending the results of
- 12 further litigation if the condemnor, not later than the seventh day
- 13 <u>after the date of the commissioners' award:</u>
- 14 (1) pays to the property owner the amount of damages
- 15 and costs awarded by the special commissioners or deposits that
- 16 amount of money with the court subject to the order of the property
- 17 owner;
- 18 (2) deposits with the court either the amount of money
- 19 awarded by the special commissioners as damages or a surety bond in
- 20 the same amount issued by a surety company qualified to do business
- 21 in this state, conditioned to secure the payment of an award of
- 22 damages by the court in excess of the award of the special
- 23 commissioners; and
- 24 (3) executes a bond that has two or more good and

- 1 solvent sureties approved by the judge of the court in which the
- 2 proceeding is pending and conditioned to secure the payment of
- 3 additional costs that may be awarded to the property owner by the
- 4 trial court or on appeal.
- 5 (b-1) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a condemnor may
- 6 not take possession under this section of condemned property
- 7 pending the results of further litigation before the 180th day
- 8 after the date of the commissioners' award.
- 9 (c) This state, a county, or a municipal corporation or an
- 10 irrigation, water improvement, or water power control district
- 11 created under legal authority:
- 12 (1) may take possession under this section of
- 13 condemned property pending the results of further litigation if the
- 14 condemnor satisfies the requirements of Subsection (a)(1); and
- 15 <u>(2)</u> is not:
- 16 <u>(A)</u> required to deposit a bond or the amount
- 17 equal to the award of damages under Subsections (a)(2)
- 18 [$\frac{\text{Subdivisions }(2)}{\text{and }(3)}$; or
- 19 <u>(B) subject to Subsection (b-1)</u> [of Subsection
- 20 $\frac{(a)}{(a)}$].
- 21 <u>(e) This section may not be construed to prohibit an</u>
- 22 agreement approved by the court between a property owner and a
- 23 condemnor that allows immediate possession of the condemned
- 24 property by the condemnor.
- 25 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 26 condemnation proceeding for which a petition is filed on or after
- 27 the effective date of this Act. A condemnation proceeding for which

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- 1 a petition is filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the petition is filed, and
- 3 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
