- 2 relating to the hours for the sale and consumption of alcoholic
- 3 beverages at certain licensed or permitted premises during special

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 105, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 105.11 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 105.11. HOURS OF SALE AND CONSUMPTION: HOTEL BARS
- 9 DURING SPECIAL EVENTS. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 10 this code, the commission, on the request of the chief executive
- 11 officer of a municipality, may extend the hours during which
- 12 <u>alcoholic beverages may be sold and consumed in a licensed or</u>
- 13 permitted premises located in a hotel in the municipality during a
- 14 special event that is being held in or near the municipality.
- 15 (b) The commission may extend the hours for the sale and
- 16 consumption of alcoholic beverages under this section for a period
- 17 not to exceed 72 consecutive hours.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
