Section 105.01(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) Except as provided in Sections 105.02, 105.03, 105.04, [and] 105.08, and 105.091, no person may sell, offer for sale, or 8 9 deliver any liquor: on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas 10 (1)11 Day; 12 (2) on Sunday; or 13 (3) before 10 a.m. or after 9 p.m. on any other day. 14 SECTION 2. Section 105.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection 15 (f) to read as follows: 16 Except as provided by Subsection (f), in [In] a standard 17 (b) hours area, a person commits an offense if the person [he] consumes 18 or possesses with intent to consume an alcoholic beverage in a 19 20 public place at any time on Sunday between 1:15 a.m. and 12 noon or 21 on any other day between 12:15 a.m. and 7 a.m. 22 Except as provided by Subsection (f), in [In] an (c) 23 extended hours area, a person commits an offense if the person [he] consumes or possesses with intent to consume an alcoholic beverage 24

1 in a public place at any time on Sunday between 2:15 a.m. and 12 noon and on any other day between 2:15 a.m. and 7 a.m. 2 3 (f) A person who is a registered guest of a hotel may consume 4 or possess alcoholic beverages in the hotel bar, as defined by Section 105.091, at any time. 5 6 SECTION 3. Chapter 105, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended 7 by adding Section 105.091 to read as follows: 8 Sec. 105.091. HOURS OF SALE; HOTEL BAR. (a) In this section, "hotel bar" means an establishment that is located in a 9 hotel and holds a permit or license providing for the on-premises 10 consumption of alcoholic beverages. 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a hotel bar may sell or 12 offer for sale alcoholic beverages at any time to a registered guest 13 14 of the hotel. 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
