A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the establishment of a bundled-pricing program to
- 3 reduce certain health care costs in the school employees and
- 4 retirees group benefits programs.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subchapter L to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER L. BUNDLED-PRICING PROGRAM
- 9 Sec. 1575.551. BUNDLED-PRICING PROGRAM. (a) The trustee
- 10 shall develop a cost-positive bundled-pricing program for health
- 11 benefit plans provided under the group program.
- 12 (b) The bundled-pricing program must be designed to reduce
- 13 <u>health care costs in the group program by contracting with a health</u>
- 14 care facility, physician, or health care provider at a consolidated
- 15 rate for an inpatient or outpatient surgery procedure that is a
- 16 covered health care or medical service under a health benefit plan
- 17 provided under the group program.
- (c) A consolidated rate described by Subsection (b) must
- 19 include all fees related to the covered surgery procedure,
- 20 including fees for a facility, physician, health care provider,
- 21 laboratory, prescription drug, or pharmacy service.
- 22 <u>Sec. 1575.552. PARTICIPATION; COST-SHARING OBLIGATION.</u>
- 23 (a) An enrollee may have an inpatient or outpatient surgery
- 24 procedure under the bundled-pricing program.

- 1 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the trustee or a
- 2 health care facility, physician, or health care provider may not
- 3 require an enrollee to pay a deductible, copayment, coinsurance, or
- 4 other cost-sharing obligation for a covered surgery procedure
- 5 provided under the bundled-pricing program.
- 6 (c) The trustee may require an enrollee in the high
- 7 deductible health plan established under Section 1575.158 to meet
- 8 the enrollee's deductible before the plan pays for a covered
- 9 surgery procedure provided under the bundled-pricing program.
- Sec. 1575.553. PROVIDER PARTICIPATION. (a) A health care
- 11 facility, physician, or health care provider is not required to
- 12 participate in the bundled-pricing program.
- 13 (b) A health care facility may not coerce a facility-based
- 14 provider, as defined by Section 1575.172, to participate in the
- 15 <u>bundled-pricing program or accept a lower rate for an inpatient or</u>
- 16 <u>outpatient surgery procedure.</u>
- Sec. 1575.554. PROMPT PAYMENT. The trustee shall ensure
- 18 that a health care facility, physician, or health care provider
- 19 that participates in the bundled-pricing program receives payment
- 20 for a covered surgery procedure not later than the 30th day after
- 21 the date the administrator receives a claim for the procedure that
- 22 <u>includes all information necessary for the administrator to pay the</u>
- 23 claim.
- Sec. 1575.555. BUNDLED-PRICING DISCLOSURE. A health care
- 25 <u>facility</u>, physician, or health care provider that participates in
- 26 the bundled-pricing program may disclose a consolidated rate for an
- 27 inpatient or outpatient surgery procedure on the facility's,

- 1 physician's, or provider's Internet website and marketing
- 2 materials.
- 3 Sec. 1575.556. PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION. The trustee
- 4 shall publish information on the bundled-pricing program,
- 5 including a list of participating health care facilities,
- 6 physicians, and health care providers, on the Teacher Retirement
- 7 System of Texas website.
- 8 Sec. 1575.557. RULEMAKING. The trustee may adopt rules as
- 9 necessary to implement this subchapter.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subchapter H to read as follows:
- 12 SUBCHAPTER H. BUNDLED-PRICING PROGRAM
- Sec. 1579.351. BUNDLED-PRICING PROGRAM. (a) The trustee
- 14 shall develop a cost-positive bundled-pricing program for health
- 15 coverage plans provided under the program.
- 16 (b) The bundled-pricing program must be designed to reduce
- 17 health care costs in the program by contracting with a health care
- 18 facility, physician, or health care provider at a consolidated rate
- 19 for an inpatient or outpatient surgery procedure that is a covered
- 20 health care or medical service under a health coverage plan
- 21 provided under the program.
- (c) A consolidated rate described by Subsection (b) must
- 23 include all fees related to the covered surgery procedure,
- 24 including fees for a facility, physician, health care provider,
- 25 <u>laboratory</u>, prescription drug, or pharmacy service.
- 26 <u>Sec. 1579.352. PARTICIPATION; COST-SHARING OBLIGATION.</u>
- 27 (a) An enrollee may have an inpatient or outpatient surgery

- 1 procedure under the bundled-pricing program.
- 2 (b) The trustee or a health care facility, physician, or
- 3 health care provider may not require an enrollee to pay a
- 4 deductible, copayment, coinsurance, or other cost-sharing
- 5 obligation for a covered surgery procedure provided under the
- 6 bundled-pricing program.
- 7 <u>Sec. 1579.353. PROVIDER PARTICIPATION. (a) A health care</u>
- 8 facility, physician, or health care provider is not required to
- 9 participate in the bundled-pricing program.
- 10 (b) A health care facility may not coerce a facility-based
- 11 provider, as defined by Section 1579.110, to participate in the
- 12 bundled-pricing program or accept a lower rate for an inpatient or
- 13 outpatient surgery procedure.
- 14 Sec. 1579.354. PROMPT PAYMENT. The trustee shall ensure
- 15 that a health care facility, physician, or health care provider
- 16 that <u>participates</u> in the bundled-pricing program receives payment
- 17 for a covered surgery procedure not later than the 30th day after
- 18 the date the administrator receives a claim for the procedure that
- 19 includes all information necessary for the administrator to pay the
- 20 claim.
- Sec. 1579.355. BUNDLED-PRICING DISCLOSURE. A health care
- 22 <u>facility</u>, physician, or health care provider that participates in
- 23 the bundled-pricing program may disclose a consolidated rate for an
- 24 inpatient or outpatient surgery procedure on the facility's,
- 25 physician's, or provider's Internet website and marketing
- 26 materials.
- Sec. 1579.356. PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION. The trustee

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- 1 shall publish information on the bundled-pricing program,
- 2 including a list of participating health care facilities,
- 3 physicians, and health care providers, on the Teacher Retirement
- 4 System of Texas website.
- 5 Sec. 1579.357. RULEMAKING. The trustee may adopt rules as
- 6 necessary to implement this subchapter.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
