9	(a) Using information provided under Subsection (b), a school
10	district shall maintain on the district's Internet website the
11	following information for each program of study offered under the
12	district's career and technology education program:
13	(1) labor market information relating to jobs to which
14	the program of study is designed to lead, including:
15	(A) the growth rate of those jobs;
16	(B) the median annual salary for those jobs; and
17	(C) any courses of study, degree requirements, or
18	other educational requirements necessary to obtain those jobs; and
19	(2) the industry-based certifications that may be
20	obtained through the program of study.
21	(b) The Texas Workforce Commission, with assistance from
22	the agency, shall biennially produce and make available to each
23	school district the labor market information described by
24	Subsection (a)(1) for each program of study offered under a

## 2 <u>(c) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to</u> 3 <u>implement this section</u>.

4 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 5 of this Act, each school district shall comply with the 6 requirements under Section 29.186, Education Code, as added by this 7 Act.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
