- SECTION 1. Chapter 24, Property Code, is amended by adding 5
- Section 24.012 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 24.012. TEMPORARY ABATEMENT OF EVICTION OF RESIDENTIAL 7
- TENANT DURING PANDEMIC. (a) In this section: 8
- (1) "Pandemic disease" means an infectious disease 9
- that spreads to a significant portion of the population of a 10
- country, multiple countries, or the world and that poses a 11
- substantial risk of a significant number of human fatalities, 12
- illnesses, or permanent long-term disabilities. 13
- 14 (2) "State of disaster" means a state of disaster
- declared by the governor under Section 418.014, Government Code. 15
- 16 (b) An action under this chapter to evict a residential
- tenant is automatically abated without a court order during the 17
- period a state of disaster related to a pandemic disease is in 18
- 19 effect.
- (c) During the period a state of disaster related to a 20
- pandemic disease is in effect, an officer may not execute a writ of 21
- possession relating to the eviction of a residential tenant. 22
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2022.
