- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 143.025, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (f-1) and amending Subsection (i) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (f-1) In a municipality with a population of more than 1.3
- 9 million and less than 2 million, an additional five points shall be
- 10 added to the examination grade of an applicant who:
- 11 (1) is a resident of the municipality in which the
- 12 applicant seeks employment;
- 13 (2) has resided in the municipality continuously for
- 14 at least one year before taking the examination; and
- 15 (3) receives a passing grade on the examination.
- 16 (i) The grade to be placed on the eligibility list for each
- 17 applicant shall be computed by adding an applicant's points under
- 18 <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (f) and (f-1), if any, to the applicant's
- 19 grade on the written examination. Each applicant's grade on the
- 20 written examination is based on a maximum grade of 100 percent and
- 21 is determined entirely by the correctness of the applicant's
- 22 answers to the questions. The minimum passing grade on the
- 23 examination is 70 percent. An applicant must pass the examination
- 24 to be placed on an eligibility list.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 143.025, Local Government Code, as
- 2 amended by this Act, applies only to an examination administered on
- 3 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
