## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the disclosure of information in department files of 3 fire fighters or police officers in certain municipalities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 143.089, Local Government Code, is 6 amended by amending Subsection (g) and adding Subsection (h) to 7 read as follows:

(g) A fire or police department may maintain a personnel 8 9 file on a fire fighter or police officer employed by the department for the department's use. The information contained in the 10 11 department file is public information subject to disclosure under 12 Chapter 552, Government Code, unless the information is made confidential under that chapter or other law [, but the department 13 14 may not release any information contained in the department file any agency or person requesting information relating to a fire 15 fighter or police officer. The department shall refer to the 16 director or the director's designee a person or agency that 17 requests information that is maintained in the fire fighter's or 18 police officer's personnel file]. 19

20 (h) Before the department responds to a request for public 21 information under Subsection (g), the department shall provide the 22 fire fighter or police officer with a copy of the request and 23 written notice of the department's intent to comply with the 24 request.
