- 8 (g) A fire or police department may maintain a personnel

- 10 for the department's use. The information contained in the
- 11 department file is public information subject to disclosure under
- 12 Chapter 552, Government Code, unless the information is made
- 13 confidential under that chapter or other law [, but the department
- 14 may not release any information contained in the department file to
- 15 any agency or person requesting information relating to a fire
- 16 fighter or police officer. The department shall refer to the
