1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 711.008, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:

1-26 (1) Subsection (a) does not apply to a cemetery established
 1-27 and operating before September 1, 2023, in a municipality:

1-28 (1) with a population of not less than 75,000 and not
 1-29 more than 95,000; and

1-30 (2) in which a state veterans cemetery is located.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
