4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 222, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER D. REGULATION OF HEALTH CARE FACILITIES SERVICING
8	RESIDENTS WITH ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE OR DEMENTIA
9	Sec. 222.101. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
10	(1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
11	Commission.
12	(2) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
13	commissioner of the commission.
14	(3) "Health care facility" means a health care
15	facility licensed by the commission.
16	(4) "Resident" means an individual who resides in a
17	health care facility.
18	Sec. 222.102. PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN RESIDENTS. The
19	executive commissioner by rule shall prohibit a health care
20	facility from placing a resident with Alzheimer's disease or
21	dementia in the same room as a resident with mental illness and a
22	history of violence.
23	Sec. 222.103. DISCIPLINARY ACTION. A health care facility
24	that violates this subchapter or a rule adopted under this

- 1 subchapter is subject to disciplinary action by the commission as
- 2 if the facility violated an applicable licensing law.
- 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Section 493.034 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 493.034. HOUSING OF INMATES WITH ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE
- 6 OR DEMENTIA. The department shall ensure that an inmate with
- 7 Alzheimer's disease or dementia who is confined in a correctional
- 8 facility operated by or under contract with the department is not
- 9 housed in the same cell as an inmate with mental illness and a
- 10 history of violence.
- 11 SECTION 3. Chapter 511, Government Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Section 511.022 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 511.022. HOUSING OF INMATES WITH ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE
- 14 OR DEMENTIA. The commission shall adopt rules prohibiting a
- 15 <u>correctional facility from housing an inmate with Alzheimer's</u>
- 16 disease or dementia in the same cell as an inmate with mental
- 17 illness and a history of violence.
- 18 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 19 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 20 Services Commission and the Commission on Jail Standards shall
- 21 adopt rules necessary to implement the changes in law made by this
- 22 Act.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
