Subchapter B, Section 1431.021, Health 11 and Safety Code, Subdivision (w) is amended to read as follows: 12 13 (w) except as provided under Subchapter M of this chapter 14 and Section 562.1085, Occupations Code, the acceptance by a person of an unused prescription or drug, in whole or in part, for the 15

- 16 purpose of resale <u>or redispensing</u>, after the prescription or drug 17 has been originally dispensed, or sold;
