| 10 | subsection does not apply to any area of a facility where an inmate |
| 11 | has a reasonable expectation of privacy, including an inmate's cell |
| 12 | or a restroom or shower. |
| 13 | (b) Security cameras required by Subsection (a) must be: |
| 14 | (1) capable of capturing and transmitting high quality |
| 15 | video; and |
| 16 | (2) positioned in a manner to eliminate blind spots in |
| 17 | the common areas. |
| 18 | SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice is not |
| 19 | required to comply with the requirements of Section 501.028, |
| 20 | Government Code, as added by this Act, until September 1, 2023. |
| 21 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. |
