Section 841.001(17), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (17) "Subdivision" means a political subdivision of 8 9 the state that is not eligible to participate in any other statewide retirement system or that is not currently participating in a 10 retirement system established by the legislature. 11 The term 12 includes [the Texas Association of Counties,] the retirement system[τ] and a city-county hospital jointly managed under 13 Subchapter B, Chapter 265, Health and Safety Code. SECTION 4. (a) Section 852.005, Government Code, as amended by this Act:

(1) applies only with respect to a person who becomes

date of this Act; and

1 (b) Notwithstanding the change in law made by this Act to 2 Section 852.005, Government Code, the Texas Municipal League shall 3 continue participation in the Texas Municipal Retirement System 4 only to the extent necessary to ensure the provision of retirement 5 and related disability and death benefits, as applicable, for 6 persons described by Subsection (a)(2) of this section.

7 (c) The board of trustees of the Texas Municipal Retirement 8 System shall adopt rules the board determines necessary to 9 implement this section.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
