- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 44.0315 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 44.0315. BIDS OR PROPOSALS REQUIRED FOR INSURANCE OR
- 9 RISK POOL CONTRACTS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), and
- 10 regardless of whether the contract is subject to competitive
- 11 bidding requirements, a school district may not enter into an
- 12 <u>insurance or risk pool contract unless:</u>
- 13 (1) the school district receives at least two bids or
- 14 proposals from different persons for the contract; and
- 15 (2) the school district files the contract with the
- 16 Texas Department of Insurance.
- 17 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to an insurance or risk
- 18 pool contract if only one source is available for the type of
- 19 coverage in the contract.
- 20 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 252, Local Government
- 21 Code, is amended by adding Section 252.025 to read as follows:
- Sec. 252.025. BIDS OR PROPOSALS REQUIRED FOR INSURANCE OR
- 23 RISK POOL CONTRACTS. Except as provided by Section 252.022(a)(7),
- 24 and regardless of whether the contract is subject to competitive

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- 1 bidding requirements, a municipality may not enter into an
- 2 insurance or risk pool contract unless:
- 3 (1) the municipality receives at least two bids or
- 4 proposals from different persons for the contract; and
- 5 (2) the municipality files the contract with the Texas
- 6 Department of Insurance.
- 7 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 262, Local Government
- 8 Code, is amended by adding Section 262.0232 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 262.0232. BIDS OR PROPOSALS REQUIRED FOR INSURANCE OR
- 10 RISK POOL CONTRACTS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), and
- 11 regardless of whether the contract is subject to competitive
- 12 bidding requirements, a county may not enter into an insurance or
- 13 risk pool contract unless:
- 14 (1) the county receives at least two bids or proposals
- 15 from different persons for the contract; and
- 16 (2) the county files the contract with the Texas
- 17 Department of Insurance.
- 18 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to an insurance or risk
- 19 pool contract if only one source is available for the type of
- 20 coverage in the contract.
- 21 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
