- 3 of a deficiency determination or jeopardy determination.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 111.008, Tax Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) On making a determination under this section, the
- 9 comptroller shall notify the person against whom a determination is
- 10 made of the determination. The notice may be given by mail, by
- 11 <u>electronic means</u>, or by personal service.
- 12 (d) A notice given by electronic means shall be addressed to
- 13 the person's e-mail address as it appears in the comptroller's
- 14 records. Service by electronic means is complete when the
- 15 comptroller transmits the notice to the person's e-mail address.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 111.022, Tax Code, is amended by
- 17 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (b) A determination made under this section becomes final on
- 20 the expiration of 20 days after the day on which the notice of the
- 21 determination was served by personal service, by electronic means,
- 22 or by mail unless a petition for a redetermination is filed before
- 23 the determination becomes final.
- 24 (b-1) A notice given by mail shall be addressed to the

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- 1 person to whom the notice is served at the person's address as it
- 2 appears in the comptroller's records. Service by mail is complete
- 3 when the notice is deposited in a United States Post Office.
- 4 (b-2) A notice given by electronic means shall be addressed
- 5 to the person's e-mail address as it appears in the comptroller's
- 6 records. Service by electronic means is complete when the
- 7 comptroller transmits the notice to the person's e-mail address.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
