A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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| 2 | relating to an acute psychiatric bed registry to list available |
| 3 | beds for the psychiatric treatment of certain individuals. |
| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is |
| 6 | amended by adding Section 531.0997 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 531.0997. ACUTE PSYCHIATRIC BED REGISTRY. (a) In this |
| 8 | section, "inpatient mental health facility" has the meaning |
| 9 | assigned by Section 571.003, Health and Safety Code. |
| 10 | (b) The commission shall develop and administer an |
| 11 | Internet-based and searchable acute psychiatric bed registry to |
| 12 | collect, aggregate, and display information about beds at inpatient |
| 13 | mental health facilities located in a county with a population of |
| 14 | four million or more that are available for the inpatient |
| 15 | psychiatric treatment of individuals. |
| 16 | (c) For each inpatient mental health facility, the acute |
| 17 | <pre>psychiatric bed registry must list:</pre> |
| 18 | (1) the name and contact information of the facility; |
| 19 | (2) the number of available beds; |
| 20 | (3) the type of individual who may be admitted; |
| 21 | (4) the level of security provided; and |
| 22 | (5) any other information that may be necessary to |
| 23 | identify appropriate beds for the inpatient psychiatric treatment |
| 24 | of individuals. |

- 1 (d) The commission shall make the acute psychiatric bed
- 2 registry available to law enforcement agencies, community service
- 3 boards, mental health facilities, public and private residential
- 4 crisis stabilization units, emergency care facilities, and
- 5 emergency care providers located in a county with a population of
- 6 four million or more. The commission may make the registry
- 7 available to any other person the commission considers appropriate.
- 8 (e) An inpatient mental health facility located in a county
- 9 with a population of four million or more shall submit to the
- 10 commission information for the acute psychiatric bed registry as
- 11 required by the commission and review the information and confirm
- 12 its accuracy to the commission at least once daily and whenever
- 13 there is a change in bed availability at the facility.
- 14 (f) An inpatient mental health facility located in a county
- 15 with a population of four million or more shall designate an
- 16 employee or employees as necessary to:
- 17 (1) submit to the commission the information required
- 18 under Subsection (e) and review the information as required by that
- 19 subsection; and
- 20 (2) serve as a contact for questions about the
- 21 <u>information submitted.</u>
- 22 (g) The commission may contract with any person the
- 23 commission considers appropriate to develop and administer the
- 24 acute psychiatric bed registry.
- 25 (h) The commission may accept gifts, grants, or donations
- 26 from any public or private source for the purpose of carrying out
- 27 this section.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Health and
- 2 Human Services Commission shall establish the acute psychiatric bed
- 3 registry required by Section 531.0997, Government Code, as added by
- 4 this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
