13	Sec. 3107.001. STATE RECOGNITION OF NATIVE AMERICAN INDIAN
14	TRIBE. (a) The Tap Pilam Coahuiltecan Nation is designated and
15	recognized by this state as a Native American Indian Tribe
16	exercising substantial governmental powers and duties.
17	(b) The tribe is recognized as eligible for all programs,
18	services, and other benefits provided to state-recognized Native
19	American Indian Tribes by the United States, this state, or any
20	other state because of the tribe members' status as Native American
21	Indians.
22	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
