- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 32.0264, Human Resources
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.0264. SUSPENSION AND [AUTOMATIC] REINSTATEMENT OF
- 8 ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN IN JUVENILE FACILITIES.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 32.0264, Human Resources Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 11 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), if, during the period
- 12 <u>a child is placed in a juvenile facility, the child is hospitalized</u>
- 13 or becomes an inpatient in another type of medical facility, the
- 14 commission shall reinstate the child's eligibility for medical
- 15 assistance during the period of the child's inpatient stay. The
- 16 executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 17 this subsection, including rules governing the procedure for
- 18 reinstating a child's eligibility for medical assistance under this
- 19 <u>subsection</u>.
- 20 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 21 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 22 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 23 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 24 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

- 1 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
