Section 32.0264, Human Resources 9 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 10 11 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), if, during the period 12 a child is placed in a juvenile facility, the child is hospitalized or becomes an inpatient in another type of medical facility, the 13 14 commission shall reinstate the child's eligibility for medical assistance during the period of the child's inpatient stay. The 15 16 executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to implement this subsection, including rules governing the procedure for 17 reinstating a child's eligibility for medical assistance under this 18 19 subsection. 20 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 22 23 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 24

1 waiver or authorization is granted.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
