The database must, to the extent possible, detail the information 22 23 described by Section 552.0225(b) with respect to each investment, 24 including investments in securities issued by foreign business

22	SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
23	of this Act:

develop and publish on the system's Internet website the investment tracking database required under Section 815.3014, Government Code, as added by this Act; and

1 (2) the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall 2 develop and publish on the system's Internet website the investment 3 tracking database required under Section 825.3014, Government 4 Code, as added by this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
