- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 418.0125 to read as follows:

- 17 (3) limits the operation or operational hours of a
- 18 religious organization established to support and serve the
- 19 propagation of a sincerely held religious belief.
- SECTION 2. Section 418.108, Government Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 22 <u>(j) The presiding officer of the governing body of a</u>
- 23 political subdivision may not issue an order or proclamation
- 24 related to a declared local state of disaster that:

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- 1 (1) restricts the free exercise of religion protected
- 2 under Chapter 110, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, or other state
- 3 or federal law;
- 4 (2) prohibits or limits a religious service conducted
- 5 <u>in a house of worship by a religious organization established to</u>
- 6 support and serve the propagation of a sincerely held religious
- 7 belief; or
- 8 (3) limits the operation or operational hours of a
- 9 religious organization established to support and serve the
- 10 propagation of a sincerely held religious belief.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
