4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 110.301(c), Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(c) This section does not apply to <u>:</u>
8	(1) a physician whose treatment of a sex offender is
9	limited to prescribing medication to the sex offender; or
10	(2) a person who is licensed in this state to practice
11	as a physician or psychologist and has completed:
12	(A) at least 24 hours of training in the specific
13	area of sex offender assessment and treatment; and
14	(B) at least eight hours of continuing education
15	training in the specific area of sex offender assessment and
16	treatment during each 12-month period in which the physician or
17	psychologist provides sex offender treatment or acts as a sex
18	offender treatment provider.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
