- 2 relating to the taking of unbanded pen-reared quail and pheasants
- 3 by certain landowners.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 42.0211 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.0211. TAKING OF UNBANDED PEN-REARED QUAIL OR
- 8 PHEASANT BY CERTAIN LANDOWNERS. (a) This section applies only to:
- 9 <u>(1) noncommercial activity; and</u>
- 10 (2) the taking of pheasant or quail on a property of at
- 11 least five contiguous acres.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding any other law requiring the banding of a
- 13 bird, a person, or the person's guest when accompanied by the
- 14 person, may take on the person's property at any time unbanded
- 15 pen-reared quail or pheasant. Nothing in this section affects the
- 16 requirement to acquire a license under Section 45.001 for the
- 17 propagation of game birds.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
