## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to provision of broadband infrastructure and connectivity

- 3 by the Lower Colorado River Authority.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 8503, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 8503.032 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8503.032. BROADBAND SERVICE INFRASTRUCTURE AND
- 8 CONNECTIVITY. (a) In this section, "broadband service" means
- 9 advanced telecommunications capability and Internet access.
- 10 (b) The authority may provide fiber capacity or facilities
- 11 for the purpose of facilitating broadband service connectivity.
- (c) The authority may not provide broadband service to a
- 13 <u>retail customer.</u>
- 14 (d) Notwithstanding any other law, Subtitle C, Title 2,
- 15 Utilities Code, does not apply to the authority.
- (e) The authority may provide fiber capacity or facilities
- 17 only on reasonable and nondiscriminatory terms and conditions.
- 18 <u>(f) The authority may not agree to lease fiber capacity or</u>
- 19 facilities to a municipality for the purpose of facilitating
- 20 broadband service connectivity, other than for communications
- 21 regarding utility operations, unless the authority:
- (1) posts on the authority's Internet website
- 23 information concerning the proposal to lease the capacity or
- 24 facilities to the municipality not less than 90 days before

- 1 entering into the lease agreement with the municipality; and
- 2 (2) for the 90-day period beginning on the date that
- 3 the authority posts information under Subdivision (1), makes the
- 4 capacity or facilities available for lease to any commercial
- 5 broadband provider that provides broadband services in the
- 6 municipality, on the authority's standard terms and conditions.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
