A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 cyberbullying in a school district and open-enrollment charter
- 4 school through the Public Education Information Management System.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 48.009, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-4) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-4) The commissioner by rule shall require each school
- 9 district and open-enrollment charter school to annually report
- 10 through the Public Education Information Management System the
- 11 <u>number of reported incidents of bullying that have occurred at each</u>
- 12 campus. The commissioner's rules shall require a district or
- 13 school to specify the number of incidents of bullying that included
- 14 cyberbullying.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
