A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the expansion of eligibility for Medicaid to all
- 3 persons for whom federal matching money is available.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 32.02473 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.02473. EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAL
- 8 ASSISTANCE. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission
- 9 shall provide medical assistance to all persons who apply for that
- 10 <u>assistance and for whom federal matching money is available.</u>
- 11 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules regarding
- 12 the provision of medical assistance as required by this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 32.02473, Human Resources Code, as added
- 14 by this Act, applies only to an initial determination or
- 15 recertification of eligibility of a person for medical assistance
- 16 under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, made on or after the date
- 17 the section is implemented, regardless of the date the person
- 18 applied for that assistance.
- 19 SECTION 3. As soon as possible after the effective date of
- 20 this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 21 Services Commission shall take all necessary actions to expand
- 22 eligibility for medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human
- 23 Resources Code, in accordance with Section 32.02473, Human
- 24 Resources Code, as added by this Act, including notifying

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- 1 appropriate federal agencies of that expanded eligibility. If
- 2 before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency
- 3 determines that any other waiver or authorization from a federal
- 4 agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the
- 5 agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 6 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 7 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022, but only
- 9 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 87th Legislature,
- 10 Regular Session, 2021, requiring the state to expand eligibility
- 11 for Medicaid to all persons for whom federal matching money is
- 12 available is approved by the voters. If that amendment is not
- 13 approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
