## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the expansion of an open-enrollment charter school.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 12.1101, Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:

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- 6 Sec. 12.1101. NOTIFICATION OF CHARTER APPLICATION OR
- 7 EXPANSION AMENDMENT [ESTABLISHMENT OF CAMPUS]. The commissioner by
- 8 rule shall adopt a procedure for providing notice to the following
- 9 persons on receipt by the commissioner of an application for a
- 10 charter for an open-enrollment charter school under Section 12.110
- 11 or of a request for an expansion amendment [notice of the
- 12 establishment of a campus as authorized] under Section 12.114
- 13  $\left[\frac{12.101(b-4)}{}\right]$ :
- 14 (1) the superintendent and the board of trustees of
- 15 each school district from which the proposed open-enrollment
- 16 charter school or campus is likely to draw students, as determined
- 17 by the commissioner; and
- 18 (2) each member of the legislature that represents the
- 19 geographic area to be served by the proposed school or campus, as
- 20 determined by the commissioner.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 12.114, Education Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 12.114. REVISION OR AMENDMENT. (a) A revision of a
- 24 charter of an open-enrollment charter school that is not an

- 1 <u>expansion amendment</u> may be made only with the approval of the
- 2 commissioner. A revision of a charter of an open-enrollment
- 3 charter school that is an expansion amendment, as defined by
- 4 commissioner rule, may be made only in the manner provided by this
- 5 section. An expansion amendment includes any amendment to a
- 6 charter that is subject to approval under this section and would
- 7 result in an increase in the funds received by an open-enrollment
- 8 charter school under Chapter 48.
- 9 (b) Not more than once each year, an open-enrollment charter
- 10 school may request approval of an expansion amendment to:
- 11 (1) increase [to revise] the maximum allowable student
- 12 enrollment described by the school's charter;
- 13 (2) add a new campus or site;
- 14 (3) extend the grade levels described by the school's
- 15 charter; or
- 16 (4) expand the geographic boundaries described by the
- 17 school's charter.
- 18 (c) A [Not later than the 60th day after the date that a]
- 19 charter holder <u>shall submit</u> [<u>submits</u>] to the commissioner a
- 20 completed request for approval for an expansion amendment. The
- 21 request must identify any public school campus located within a
- 22 five-mile radius of the charter holder's existing or proposed
- 23 campus that may be affected by the requested expansion amendment.
- 24 The commissioner shall publicly post the request for approval for
- 25 an expansion amendment not later than the 10th business day after
- 26 the date the charter holder submits the request[, as defined by
- 27 commissioner rule, including a new school amendment, the

- commissioner shall provide to the charter holder written notice of 1 approval or disapproval of the amendment]. 2 3 The commissioner may approve an expansion amendment
- 4 only if:
- 5 (1) the charter holder has complied with all expansion amendment requirements, including providing notice in the manner 6 7 required by Section 12.1101;
- 8 (2) the overall performance rating assessed for the most recently completed school year under Section 39.054 for at 9 10 least 90 percent of all campuses operated by the charter holder is A, B, or C; and 11
- 12 (3) the charter holder has:
- (A) an accreditation status of accredited; and 13
- 14 (B) a student population composed of students:
- 15 (i) at least 50 percent of whom are in
- grades assessed under Subchapter B, Chapter 39; and 16
- 17 (ii) at least 50 percent of whom have been
- enrolled in the school for three or more consecutive school years. 18
- (e) The commissioner may not waive a provision of this 19
- section [A charter holder may submit a request for approval for an 20
- expansion amendment up to 18 months before the date on which the 21
- expansion will be effective. A request for approval of an expansion 22
- amendment does not obligate the charter holder to complete the 23
- 24 proposed expansion].
- 25 SECTION 3. Sections 12.101(b-4) and (b-10), Education Code,
- 26 are repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 27
