SECTION 2. Section 9.32, Penal Code, is amended by adding 10 11 Subsection (e) to read as follows: 12 (e) For purposes of Subsection (b)(3), a finder of fact may not consider the defense provided by Section 8.02 in determining 13 14 whether the actor was engaged in criminal activity at the time the deadly force was used. 15 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 16 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 17 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed 18 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the 19 20 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 21 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 22 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
