H.B. No. 1796

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the division of and assumption of road district authority by fresh water supply districts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 53.029, Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 53.029. [DIVISION OF OR] ASSUMPTION OF ROAD DISTRICT 7 AUTHORITY [BY CERTAIN DISTRICTS]. (a) [This section applies to a 8 9 district located in a county that: [(1) has a population of 1.3 million or more and in 10 which a municipality with a population of more than one million is 11 primarily located; or 12 13 [(2) is adjacent to a county having the 14 characteristics described by Subdivision (1). [(b) A district covered by this section may be divided into 15 16 two new districts if it has no outstanding bonded debt and is not levying ad valorem taxes. The division procedure is prescribed by 17 Sections 53.030 to 53.041 of this code. 18 [(c)] The board of a district [covered by this section] may 19 order an election to be held in the district to determine whether 20 21 the district should assume the rights, authority, privileges, and functions of a road district under Article III, Section 52(b)(3), 22 23 of the Texas Constitution. The election shall be ordered, conducted, and the results canvassed in the manner provided by the 24

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1 applicable provisions of this chapter and the Election Code. The ballots for the election shall be printed to provide for voting for 2 3 or against: The assumption by the _____ Fresh Water Supply District of the rights, authority, privileges, and functions of a 4 road district under Article III, Section 52(b)(3), of the Texas 5 Constitution. If a majority of the persons voting in the election 6 vote in favor of the proposition, the district shall assume the 7 8 rights, authority, privileges, and functions of a road district operating under Article III, Section 52(b)(3), of the Texas 9 10 Constitution, Chapter 257, Transportation Code, and other general laws of this state relating to road districts. 11

12 (b) [(d)] A district operating as a road district may not issue bonds or otherwise lend its credit for road district purposes 13 except on approval of not less than two-thirds of the qualified 14 15 voters of the district voting at an election called and held for that purpose. The total amount of bonds, notes, and other 16 17 obligations of the district issued or incurred under this subsection may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed valuation of 18 19 real property in the district.

20 (c) [(e)] A district that has adopted the rights, authority, privileges, and functions of a road district in the 21 manner provided by Subsection (a) [(c)] may, following approval of 22 23 a construction contract by the district's governing body, reimburse expenditures as provided by Sections 257.003(a) 24 and (b), Transportation Code, without any additional approval under Section 25 26 257.003, Transportation Code.

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SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 53, Water Code, is amended

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1	by adding Section 53.0291 to read as follows:
2	Sec. 53.0291. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. A district may be
3	divided into two new districts as provided by Sections 53.030
4	through 53.041 if the district:
5	(1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and
6	(2) is not levying ad valorem taxes.
7	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
