4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is

6	Sec. 13.009. ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION. (a) The
7	secretary of state shall, in coordination with the Department of
8	Public Safety, implement a program to allow a person with an
9	unexpired driver's license or personal identification card issued
10	in this state to complete a voter registration application over the
11	Internet from a secure Internet website.
12	(b) The Internet website established under this section
13	<pre>must allow a person to submit:</pre>
14	(1) an initial application for registration; and
15	(2) an application to update a voter registration
16	record.
17	(c) When a person submits an application under this section,
18	the secretary of state shall compare the information provided by
19	the applicant against Department of Public Safety records.
20	(d) The completed online application and information from
21	the Department of Public Safety, including the applicant's digital
22	signature, shall be provided to:
23	(1) the county voter registration office for the
24	county where the applicant currently resides; and

- 3 (e) An application electronically submitted under this

- 8 <u>(f)</u> The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
