5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:								
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 441, Government Code, is								
7	amended by adding Section 441.231 to read as follows:								
8	Sec. 441.231. ONLINE LIBRARY RESOURCES FOR PRIMARY AND								
9	SECONDARY SCHOOLS. (a) The commission shall use funds								
10	appropriated to the commission or consortium services fees								
11	collected from school districts under Section 441.224(b) to								
12	purchase online library resources for primary and secondary schools								
13	that:								
14	(1) meet the standards adopted by the State Board of								
15	Education under this section; and								
16	(2) have adopted Internet safety policies and								
17	technology protection measures meeting the requirements for								
18	certification under 47 U.S.C. Sections 254(h)(5)(B) and (C).								
19	(b) The State Board of Education by rule shall adopt								
20	standards for online library resources purchased under Subsection								
21	<u>(a).</u>								
22	(c) The commission may purchase online library resources								
23	under Subsection (a) only if the vendor providing the resources								
24	certifies that the resources comply with:

1	(1) the standards adopted by the State Board of
2	Education under this section; and
3	(2) 47 U.S.C. Section 254(h)(5).
4	(d) If the State Board of Education finds that a vendor
5	subject to Subsection (c) is not substantially complying with the
6	standards adopted by the board or the requirements of 47 U.S.C.
7	Section 254(h)(5), the board shall notify the vendor of the
8	vendor's noncompliance. If the vendor fails to substantially
9	comply with the standards and federal law on or before the 90th day
10	after the date the vendor receives the notice, the board shall
11	notify the commission and the commission may withhold further
12	payments to the vendor pending verification of compliance with the
13	standards and federal law.
14	(e) If a vendor described by Subsection (d) fails to verify
15	that the vendor is in compliance with the standards and federal law
16	on or before the 180th day after the date the vendor receives the
17	notice of noncompliance described by that subsection, the
18	commission may consider the vendor's act of noncompliance a breach
19	of contract.
20	(f) Not later than December 1 of each year, the commission
21	shall submit to the Legislative Budget Board and the office of the
22	governor a report on any issues related to vendor compliance with:
23	(1) standards adopted by the State Board of Education
24	under this section; and
25	(2) technology protection measures required by 47
26	U.S.C. Section 254(h)(5).
27	(g) The State Board of Education by rule shall establish a
