- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.905(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The council shall:
- 8 (1) survey current resources for services for the
- 9 homeless in this state;
- 10 (2) initiate an evaluation of the current and future
- 11 needs for the services;
- 12 (3) assist in coordinating and providing statewide
- 13 services for all homeless individuals in this state;
- 14 (4) increase the flow of information among separate
- 15 providers and appropriate authorities;
- 16 (5) develop guidelines to monitor the provision of
- 17 services for the homeless and the methods of delivering those
- 18 services;
- 19 (6) provide technical assistance to the housing
- 20 finance division of the department in assessing the need for
- 21 housing for individuals with special needs in different localities;
- 22 (7) coordinate with the Texas Workforce Commission,
- 23 local workforce development boards, homeless shelters, and public
- 24 and private entities to provide homeless individuals information on

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- 1 services available to assist them in obtaining employment and job
- 2 training;
- 3 (8) establish a central resource and information
- 4 center for the homeless in this state; [and]
- 5 (9) <u>ensure that the Homeless Management Information</u>
- 6 System is administered by the lead agency for each continuum of care
- 7 <u>in this state; and</u>
- 8 <u>(10)</u> ensure that local or statewide nonprofit
- 9 organizations perform the duties under this section that the
- 10 council is unable to perform.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
