- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.002(s), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (s) In this subsection, "bullying" has the meaning assigned
- 8 by Section 37.0832 and "harassment" has the meaning assigned by
- 9 Section 37.001. In addition to any other essential knowledge and
- 10 skills the State Board of Education adopts for the health
- 11 curriculum under Subsection (a)(2)(B), the board shall adopt for
- 12 the health curriculum, in consultation with the Texas School Safety
- 13 Center, essential knowledge and skills that include:
- 14 (1) evidence-based practices that will effectively
- 15 address awareness, prevention, identification, self-defense in
- 16 response to, and resolution of and intervention in bullying and
- 17 harassment; and
- (2) evidence-based practices that will effectively
- 19 teach students respect for another person's autonomy and confidence
- 20 <u>in protecting their own bodily autonomy.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 22 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
