- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.605, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A clerk may carry over from the current calendar year to
- 8 the following calendar year not more than 10 hours of completed
- 9 continuing education courses that exceed the number of hours of
- 10 completed continuing education courses required under Subsection
- 11 <u>(c).</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
