1-15 relating to annual continuing education requirements for certain
1-16 court clerks.

1-17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-18 SECTION 1. Section 51.605, Government Code, is amended by
1-19 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-20 (d) A clerk may carry over from the current calendar year to
1-21 the following calendar year not more than 10 hours of completed
1-22 continuing education courses that exceed the number of hours of
1-23 completed continuing education courses required under Subsection
1-24 (c).

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
