Subchapter B, Chapter 156, Family Code, 6 7 amended by adding Section 156.106 to read as follows: Sec. 156.106. MODIFICATION OF ORDER BASED ON DEATH OF 8 9 CONSERVATOR. (a) The death of a person who is a conservator of a child is a material and substantial change of circumstances 10 sufficient to justify a temporary order and modification of an 11 existing court order or portion of a decree that provides for the 12 appointment of a conservator or that sets the terms and conditions 13 14 of conservatorship or for the possession of or access to the child. (b) Before modifying an order under Section 156.101 based on 15 16 a material and substantial change of circumstances described by Subsection (a), the court must consider any term or condition of the 17 order or portion of a decree that denies possession of the child to 18 a parent or imposes restrictions or limitations on the parent's 19 right to possession of or access to the child. The court shall 20 include those restrictions or limitations in a modification of the 21 order if the court finds that the restrictions or limitations 22 23 continue to be in the best interest of the child.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
