Section 30.06, Penal Code, is amended by adding 7 Subsection (e-4) to read as follows: 8 (e-4) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that the license holder is a guest of a hotel, as defined by Section 9 2155.101, Occupations Code, and the license holder: 10 11 (1) carries or stores a handgun in the license holder's 12 hotel room; 13 (2) carries a handgun directly en route to or from the 14 hotel or the license holder's hotel room; 15 (3) carries a handgun directly en route to or from the license holder's vehicle located on the hotel property, including a 16 17 vehicle in a parking area provided for hotel guests; or (4) carries or stores a handgun in the license holder's 18 vehicle located on the hotel property, including a vehicle in a 19 parking area provided for hotel guests. 20 21 SECTION 6. 14	effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense
15	was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element
16	of the offense occurred before that date.
