- 3 and the Texas Constitution in the curriculum requirements for

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.025, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-22) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-22) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules
- 9 requiring students enrolled in high school to complete a course on
- 10 the United States Constitution and the Texas Constitution as part
- 11 of a district's social studies curriculum.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 28.025(b-22), Education Code, as added
- 13 by this Act, applies beginning with students who enter the ninth
- 14 grade during the 2021-2022 school year.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
