9	Sec. 241.351. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "children's		
10	isolation unit" means an isolation unit in a hospital licensed		
11	under this chapter that is designed to provide health care services		
12	to children with highly contagious infectious diseases.		
13	Sec. 241.352. LIMITATION ON CIVIL LIABILITY OF CHILDREN'S		
14	ISOLATION UNIT. A children's isolation unit that has instituted		
15	isolation protocols is not liable for any claim, damage, or loss		
16	arising from the provision of health care services to children with		
17	highly contagious diseases, unless the act or omission proximately		
18	causing the claim, damage, or loss constitutes gross negligence or		
19	wilful misconduct.		
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
