- 12 13 ISOLATION UNIT. A children's isolation unit that has instituted 14 isolation protocols is not liable for any claim, damage, or loss 15 arising from the provision of health care services to children with 16 highly contagious diseases, unless the act or omission proximately 17 causing the claim, damage, or loss constitutes gross negligence or 18 19 wilful misconduct.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
