- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.03(c)(3), Penal Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Secured area" means an area of an airport
- 8 terminal building to which access is controlled by the inspection
- 9 of persons and property under federal law, or an aircraft parking
- 10 area that is used by common carriers in air transportation but not
- 11 by general aviation and to which access is controlled under federal
- 12 <u>law.</u> The term does not include a baggage claim area, a motor
- 13 vehicle parking area used by passengers, employees, or persons
- 14 awaiting an arrival, or an area used by the public to pick up or drop
- 15 off passengers or employees.
- SECTION 2. Section 46.03(e), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 17 as follows:
- 18 (e) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (a)(5)
- 19 that the actor:
- 20 <u>(1)</u> checked all firearms as baggage in accordance with
- 21 federal or state law or regulations before entering a secured area;
- 22 or
- 23 (2) was authorized by a federal agency or the airport
- 24 operator to possess a firearm in a secured area.

- 1 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 2 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 5 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 6 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 7 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 8 before that date.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
