## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study and report by the comptroller on local and state
- 3 supply chain disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "COVID-19" means the
- 6 2019 novel coronavirus disease.
- 7 SECTION 2. STUDY. (a) The comptroller of public accounts
- 8 shall conduct a study to identify and evaluate local and state
- 9 supply chain disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 10 (b) In conducting the study, the comptroller shall:
- 11 (1) assess the overall cost to this state of local and
- 12 state supply chain disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic;
- 13 (2) determine the number of jobs affected by local and
- 14 state supply chain disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic;
- 15 (3) determine which industries were most affected by
- 16 local and state supply chain disruptions caused by the COVID-19
- 17 pandemic; and
- 18 (4) recommend policies and procedures for maintaining
- 19 effective supply chains in future health and economic crises.
- SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than September 1, 2022, the
- 21 comptroller shall prepare and submit to the governor and the
- 22 legislature a report containing the results of the study and any
- 23 recommendations for legislative or other action to aid in this
- 24 state's recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic and prepare for future

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- 1 health and economic crises.
- 2 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2023.
- 3 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 4 1, 2021.
