- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 821, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subchapter E to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER E. TREATMENT OF ELEPHANTS

- 8 Sec. 821.101. USE OF CERTAIN DEVICES ON ELEPHANTS
- 9 PROHIBITED. A person may not use any device, including a bullhook,
- 10 ankus, baseball bat, axe handle, or pitchfork, to train or control
- 11 the behavior of an elephant in a manner that inflicts physical pain
- 12 <u>on the elephant.</u>
- Sec. 821.102. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A person commits an
- 14 offense if the person violates Section 821.101.
- (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,
- 16 except that the offense is a state jail felony if it is shown at the
- 17 trial of the offense that the defendant has previously been
- 18 convicted two or more times of an offense under this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
